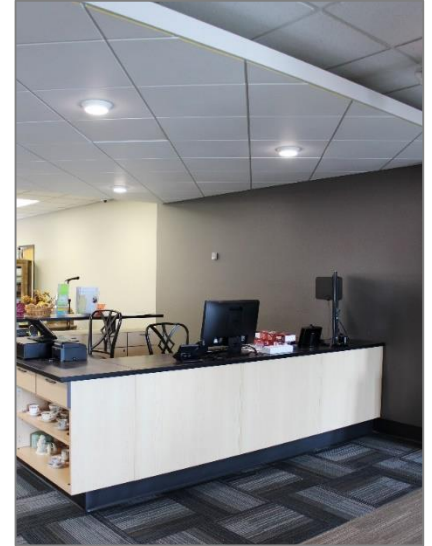
Michael J. Warren – General Manager:

Anticipated Finish: End of September

Aspirus is a non-profit, community-directed health system with more than 7,000 employees, serving communities throughout northern and central Wisconsin, as well as the Upper Peninsula of Michigan. The clinic is more than doubling in size with the construction of a 40,000-square-foot, two-story addition to provide space for walk-in, specialty and emergency services as well as future space for expanded services. VerHalen is working on acoustical ceilings solutions, framing and hanging drywall.

St. Camillus Community-Based Residential Facility & Jesuit Residence

VerHalen is providing the acoustical ceilings at this 192,000-square-foot project. The expansion at St. Camillus, a Life Plan Community in Wauwatosa, includes a 72 unit Assisted Living building with apartments for both memory care and frail elderly residents, a new 50 unit Jesuit Building with its own chapel, and a 2 story 20 unit Community House for Camillian priests and brothers.

Green Bay Botanical Garden Amphitheatre

Start Date: Fall 2016

Anticipated Finish: Construction to wrap up in June, with the Ribbon Cutting Ceremony taking place on September 7th, 2017.

Our Furniture & Design team provided an extensive furniture solution for this remarkable Green Bay project. This 2.5-acre project is highlighted by an amphitheater and green space with room for concert and event crowds of 1,500 to 2,000 people. The project also features two small gardens for private events, a shelter with concessions and catering, restrooms, a green room and classroom space. The mission of the new Amphitheatre is to connect people with nature and the arts in the summer months.
