Bader Philanthropies, a Milwaukee based non-profit organization, is relocating from Milwaukee's Historic Third Ward to the city's Harambee neighborhood. The new space will include more than 22,000 square feet of meeting rooms and offices. In addition to the building, there are plans for nearly 50 guest parking spaces and green space. The foundation consists of funds from the Helen Daniels Bader Fund and the Isabel and Alfred Bader Fund and focuses on the health of older adults, improving the lives of low-income Milwaukee residents and Jewish education in Milwaukee. VerHalen is providing drywall work at this project.
